Australia has an acute shortage of well trained and qualified staff to meet this social need. This situation is more critical in regional areas in Australia.

“To keep the current ratio of aged care workers to people aged 85+ we need to add 77,976 workers in the next 10 years, a recruitment goal of 650 aged care workers per month” – McCrindle, Community Services and Health Industry Skills Council

“The initial roll-out of the National Disability Insurance Scheme includes both a launch and a transition phase. During this latter component, scheme numbers are forecast to increase from just over 30,000 in 2015-16 to over 450,000 in 2018-19.” – Australian Government National Commission of Audit

The programme comprises of 3 stages – with the first 2 stages undertaken in the first year of study and the 3rd stage undertaken in the second year of study.

STAGE 1 – CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) – this qualification is an entry level qualification designed to provide the student with the practical skills to enter the workforce.

STAGE 2 - CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support – this qualification will further enhance the skill knowledge and practical training of students.

STAGE 3 - CHC52015 Diploma of Community Services – this qualification is a higher level qualification and will provide students with the practical skills to manage individual cases and work more autonomous and without supervision. These skills are essential when working in home care, disability or community services and will enhance the opportunities of students to further their careers within an organisation.
